Rules, Regulations And Policies

PROPERTY DIRECTORY

Each member will receive a custom three-ring binder contain-ing detailed maps, directions, property descriptions, property rules and rates for each property. Also included is a copy of your Membership Agreement, Club rules, regulations and policies, a supply of Reservation Cards and Guest Agreement forms. If lost, binders can be replaced for \$30.00.

CATCH AND RELEASE FISHING

Most Club waters are managed to provide the largest possible population of big, wild trout. Therefore, catch and release fishing is the policy at all Club properties. Club members are urged to practice **CPR** on the fish that they bring to net--**Catch**, **Photograph**, **Release**. Regulations for each tract, and described in the Property Directory care frequently most. as described in the Property Directory, are frequently more stringent than State regulations, but members and guests are expected to strictly comply. The outstanding fish-ing Club members enjoy is due to catch and release.

FLIES ONLY

Fishing is restricted to single-barb flies only on all Club waters. Metallic and plastic lures are not permitted. Bait fishing or chumming is also not permitted. Barbless flies are recommended.

LIMITS ON NUMBER OF ANGLERS

To assure the highest quality experience possible, a limited number of angler's are permitted on each property each day. A somewhat larger number are allowed if all are part of a

FISHING BY RESERVATION ONLY

To fish, you must first obtain an authorization number from our reservation office. The number is to be filled in on your personalized reservation card, along with the property number and date or dates of the reservation. The reserva-tion card is to be prominently displayed on the dash of your vehicle while parked at the fishing area. To assure the ex-pected quality experience for those with reservations, any person on the property without authorization for that date will be cardled. the property without authorization for that date will be guilty of trespass and, if apprehended, will be aggres-sively prosecuted.

RESERVATION LIMITS

Reservations will be accepted for groups of two or more for any date or consecutive dates during the season. However, to give everyone a chance to fish all waters, only one un-used reservation can be in effect on any specific parcel at any

RESERVATION FEE

A non-refundable \$5 fee is charged for one to three reservations when those reservations are being made at the same

DAY RATE CHARGES

Rocky Mountain Angling Club charges are based primarily on a day use rate. Daily rates vary widely from \$45/day to \$150/day with the average about \$75/day. Young people, age 13-17, are discounted 25% and children 12 and under are free at most properties.

AFTERNOON RATES

An afternoon rate that is 25% less than the full day rate is offered on most properties; however, reservations at the afternoon rate will be confirmed only after 12:00 noon on the

MANNER OF PAYMENT

Payment is due when the reservation is made. Members are encouraged to furnish a credit card number (Visa, Master Card, American Express or Discover) and authorization to charge by phone.

RESERVATION CANCELLATION

Full refund of day rate charges will be made if a reservation is cancelled more than 48 hours before the first day of the dates reserved. A 50% refund will be made if the cancellation occurs within 48 hours, but before the first day reserved. No refund will be made if the cancellation is not made until the day of the reservation.

RESERVATION PHONE HOURS

Call anytime 7 days a week between 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. from Apr. 1–Oct. 31. Call Monday through Friday from Nov. 1–Mar. 31 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Denver-area residents may call (303) 421-6239. Our toll-free number is 800-524-1814. Our FAX number is (303) 421-4807.

GUESTS ARE WELCOME

You are not restricted in the number of guests you are permitted to take with you onto Club waters, but payment of the day rate charge must be made for each guest at time of the reservation. All guests or their legal guardians, must sign the Guest Agreement and send it to the Club before the reserved date.

INDIVIDUAL/FAMILY MEMBERSHIP

All memberships, except business memberships, are deemed to be family memberships. One-time initiation fee is currently \$350.

BUSINESS MEMBERSHIP

Memberships are permitted in business names currently. The one-time business membership initiation fee is \$725. Each key employee authorized to use the business membership must also pay the annual dues and complete a membership ap-plication. Each key employee will then receive his or her own copy of the Property Directory and a subscription to the Club Newsletter.

ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP DUES

An annual fee is charged each member to cover the cost of the Property Directory and a Newsletter subscription. The current rate is \$160 per year. Annual fee will be due in January of every year regardless of your start date. Annual fees will not be prorated

IDENTITY DISCLOSURE

A member's identity will be revealed to others fishing the property that day if a request is made through the reserva-tion office. Members are encouraged to say "Hi", discuss plans to minimize the disruption of each others fishing and even get acquainted if you both wish. But remember, many join the Club to get away from the crowds. Please be sensi-tive to another member's desire for solitude.

PROPERTY IS PATROLLED

Club employees, authorized agents and landowners will, on an irregular basis, check to make sure that only members and guests with valid reservations are using the property and that all members and guests are complying with the property regulations. Violation of any regulation may subject the member and guests to immediate expulsion from the property.

RESPECT PRIVATE PROPERTY

Each member and guest must agree to respect all rights of the property owners who are allowing us on their land to fish and to personally be responsible for any damage caused on the property.

NO LITTERING

Trash cans are not provided on Club properties. Members and guests are expected to take off the property all that is taken on. That means every little piece of litter. The next member should find it as pristine as you found it. If you ever find it trashed when you get there, please call the Club office that day. We will know who fished the site last, unless there has been a trespasser. We will investigate and arrange clean up.

SANITATION FACILITIES

They can be described in one word - none. No smelly outhouses or port-a-potties. Please treat the area as you would a

FIRES PROHIBITED
Fires are prohibited on Club properties unless otherwise noted in the property directory. A fire ring will be provided on any property where fires are permitted. Fires are not to be started outside of a designated fire ring.

Camping is prohibited on Club properties unless specifi-cally allowed. However, directions to nearby public and pri-vate campgrounds are provided in the property directory. Where overnight camping is permitted, camping areas are unimproved; i.e., no hookups, water, bathrooms.

MEMBERSHIP TERMINATION

Rocky Mountain Angling Club reserves the right to termi-nate the membership of any member, without a stated rea-son, by notifying the member of the termination in writing and making a pro rata refund of the membership fee.

RULE CHANGES

Rocky Mountain Angling Club reserves the right to change any of its rules, regulations, policies, practices or fees with written notice to the membership. Publication in the news letter will be deemed to be adequate written notice.
